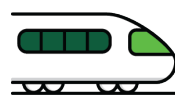

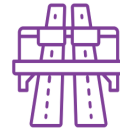

Commuter Choice Benefits in FY 2022

Commuter Choice projects rebounded strongly in 2022 and continued to serve the region's commuters with reliable service. Over 4,000 more people moved through the two corridors each day in spring 2022 — more than five times 2021 figures.
