THE NORTHERN VIRGINIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION APPOINTS NEW OFFICERS, VRE, VTA and METRO BOARD REPRESENTATIVES FOR 2012

Arlington, VA— At its first business meeting of the new year on January 5, 2012, the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission (NVTC) selected new officers and representatives to regional transportation boards, conducted a public hearing on its 2012 work program, agreed on several new initiatives and approved its FY 2013 administrative budget.
