### THE NORTHERN VIRGINIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION APPOINTS NEW OFFICERS, VRE, VTA and METRO BOARD REPRESENTATIVES FOR 2012

**Arlington, VA**— At its first business meeting of the new year on January 5, 2012, the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission (NVTC) selected new officers and representatives to regional transportation boards, conducted a public hearing on its 2012 work program, agreed on several new initiatives and approved its FY 2013 administrative budget.
