Route 1 Corridor Bus Study Draft Presented to Public

The NVTC-managed Route 1 Corridor Bus Study will be presented in draft form over the next two weeks in Alexandria and Woodbridge. The meetings are open and the general public is invited to ask questions and make comments.

Based on a needs assessment, the study will recommend new transit services, modifications of existing services, and locations for future transit facilities in the Route 1 Corridor of Fairfax and Prince William Counties. The findings and recommendations from this consulting study will serve as input to the two-year Route 1 Corridor Location Study, which will include some preliminary engineering and produce an environmental document.

The study was managed by the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission and conducted by SG Associates with TransManagement, Inc. and DMJM+Harris.
