NVTC TO WELCOME METRO GM/CEO AND BOARD CHAIR **Commission will also learn about proposed transit projects for I-395/95**

Arlington, Va. - The Northern Virginia Transportation Commission will welcome the leaders of Metro and the Metro Board of Directors and hear details on 14 proposed projects designed to reduce traffic congestion in the I-395/95 corridor at their monthly meeting this Thursday.

The Commission [will welcome](#) Metro GM/CEO Randy Clarke and Metro Board Chair Valerie Santos. Mr. Clarke and Ms. Santos will update the Commission on recent activity at Metro including the passage of the FY 2026 budget and proposals for future improvements, and Commissioners will have an opportunity to ask questions.

I-395/95 Commuter Choice Proposed Projects

NVTC staff will present the Commission with their [recommended](#) Program of Projects for I-395/95 Commuter Choice. The program reinvests toll revenues into projects that move more people through Northern Virginia's most traffic-congested corridors.

This year's draft Program of Projects includes 12 potential bus service enhancements for ART, DASH, Fairfax Connector, Metrobus and OmniRide; one new Metrobus route; and the improvement of VRE's Leeland Road Station.

Taken together, these projects would support an estimated 3,800 additional weekday transit trips in the I-395/95 corridor upon their full implementation. They are estimated to result in over 53,000 hours of travel time savings and a reduction of nearly 22 million vehicle miles traveled (VMT) annually.

NVTC and the Potomac and Rappahannock Transportation Commission, which has shared responsibility for the Commuter Choice program, will be asked to adopt the I-395/95 Program of Projects at their June meetings.
