Dorsey to represent NVTC on WMATA Board of Directors



NVTC Appoints Arlington County Board Member as WMATA Board Principal

Arlington, VA - The Northern Virginia Transportation
Commission (NVTC) today appointed Arlington County
Board Member Christian Dorsey as the principal member
on the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority
(WMATA) Board of Directors. Dorsey, who has served as
an alternate on the WMATA board since 2016, assumes
the term of Fairfax County Supervisor Cathy Hudgins,
which expires in 2021. The commission appointed
Hudgins to serve as an alternate to WMATA Board
Member Jim Corcoran, Virginia's gubernatorial appointee.
Hudgins has served on the WMATA board since 2004. The
commission's vote was taken in anticipation of a new
Virginia law that takes effect July 1, 2018, providing
dedicated funding for WMATA and governance reforms.
