NVTC EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING SUMMARY NVTC Suite #230 Small Conference Room Navy League Building – Arlington, Virginia July 11, 2019

Chairman Letourneau called the Executive Committee meeting to order at 6:21 P.M.

The June 6th Executive Committee Meeting Summary and the May Management Advisory Committee (MAC) Meeting Summary were provided. Committee members had no changes to the Executive Committee Meeting Summary.

Ms. Hudgins reported that the WMATA Committee met on June 27th to discuss the update to the Annual *Report on the Performance and Condition of WMATA*. The committee provided staff with guidance on strategies regarding the WMATA Board, parking, fare policy, fare pass products and the role of Metrobus in the region. Program Advisory Committee Chair Dave Snyder reported that the next Program Advisory Committee meeting is scheduled for August 1st as a work session to talk through revisions to Commuter Choice scoring criteria.

The Executive Committee reviewed the July 11th NVTC Agenda, which includes routine actions as part of the Consent Agenda, as well as authorizing a letter to WMATA requesting data. Action will be requested on the release of the I-395/95 Commuter Choice FY2020 application scores for public comment. Staff will provide presentations on the Envision Route 7 project and an update

on fare technologies. There are also the regular reports from the WMATA Board members and NVTC WMATA Committee, as well as VRE and DRPT.

There was discussion of last month's NVTC letter to WMATA on an ethics inquiry. It was noted that WMATA did not respond to NVTC's letter, although WMATA did release a response to Maryland Governor Hogan and Virginia Governor Northam's letter requesting information on the ethics inquiry.

Mr. Smedberg and Mr. Dorsey gave a brief update on WMATA activities. The WMATA Board elected new officers and Mr. Smedberg was named Board chair. Committee assignments were also approved. Mr. Dorsey will remain chair of the Finance and Capital Committee and Michael Goldman (Maryland) was appointed chair of the Safety and Operations Committee.

The Executive Committee reviewed upcoming Commission activities. Ms. Mattice reminded the committee that there is no August meeting. NVTC expects the fall to be busy with NVTC's *Report on the Performance and Condition of WMATA*, I-395/95 Commuter Choice project selection, I-66 Commuter Choice two-year call for projects, NVTC Legislative Agenda development, and I-66 MOA amendments.

DRPT Director Mitchell gave a brief DRPT update. She stated that DRPT is planning to brief the Commission on the Long Bridge project at a future meeting. The committee asked her to provide cost estimates for the Long Bridge. Ms. Mitchell also noted that WMATA provided data by the deadline which is required by legislation. DRPT is currently reviewing the two letters.

The Executive Committee then went into Closed Session to discuss the upcoming executive director performance evaluation. Senator Ebbin moved, with a second by Mr. Smedberg, the following motion:

Pursuant to the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (Section 2.2-3711A(1)) of the Code of Virginia), the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission Executive Committee authorizes discussion in closed session concerning a personnel matter.

The vote in favor was cast by committee members Dorsey, Ebbin, Hudgins, Letourneau, Smedberg and Snyder.

After returning to Open Session, Senator Ebbin moved, with a second by Mr. Smedberg, the following certification:

The Northern Virginia Transportation Commission Executive Committee certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge and with no individual member dissenting, at the just concluded Closed Session:

 Only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Freedom of Information Act were discussed; and 2) Only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed session was convened were heard, discussed or considered.

The vote in favor was cast by committee members Dorsey, Ebbin, Hudgins, Letourneau, Smedberg and Snyder.

The meeting adjourned at 7:00 P.M.
