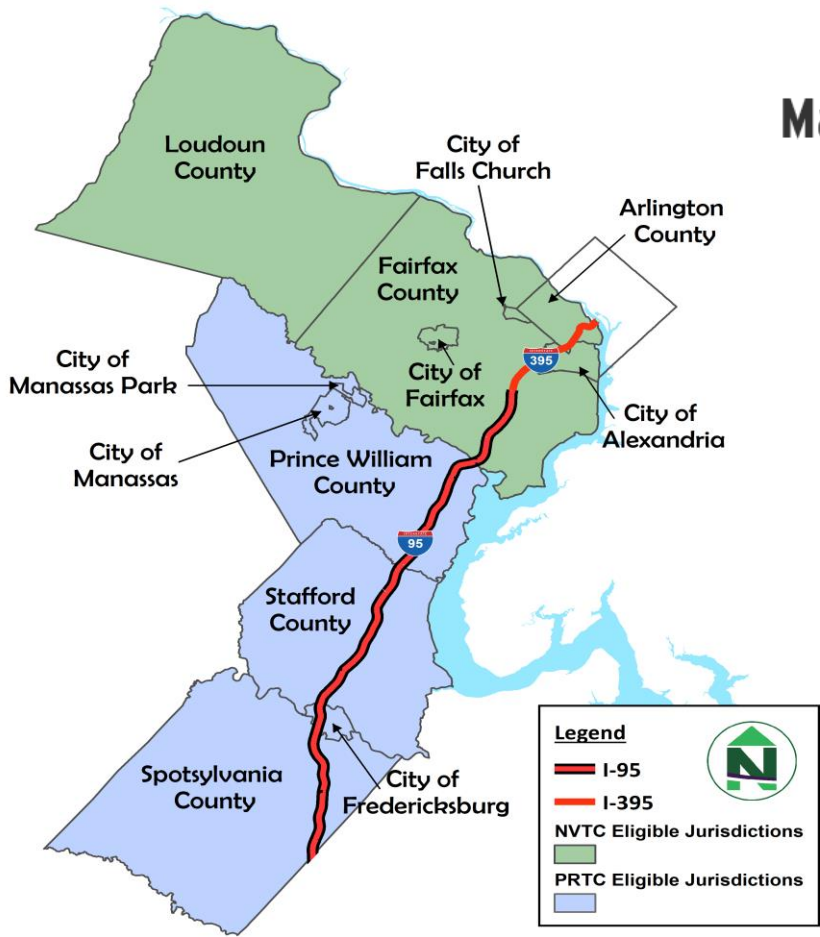

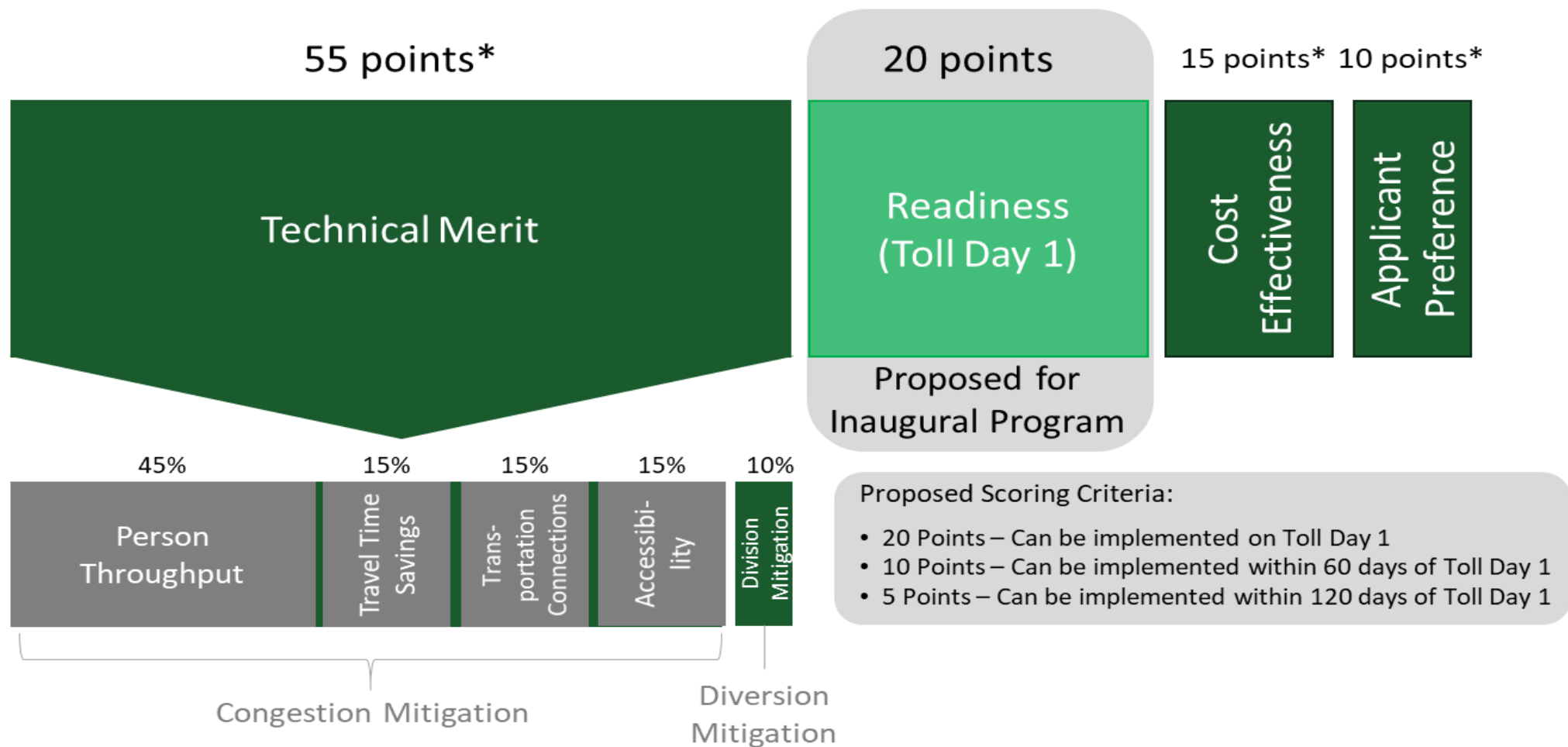

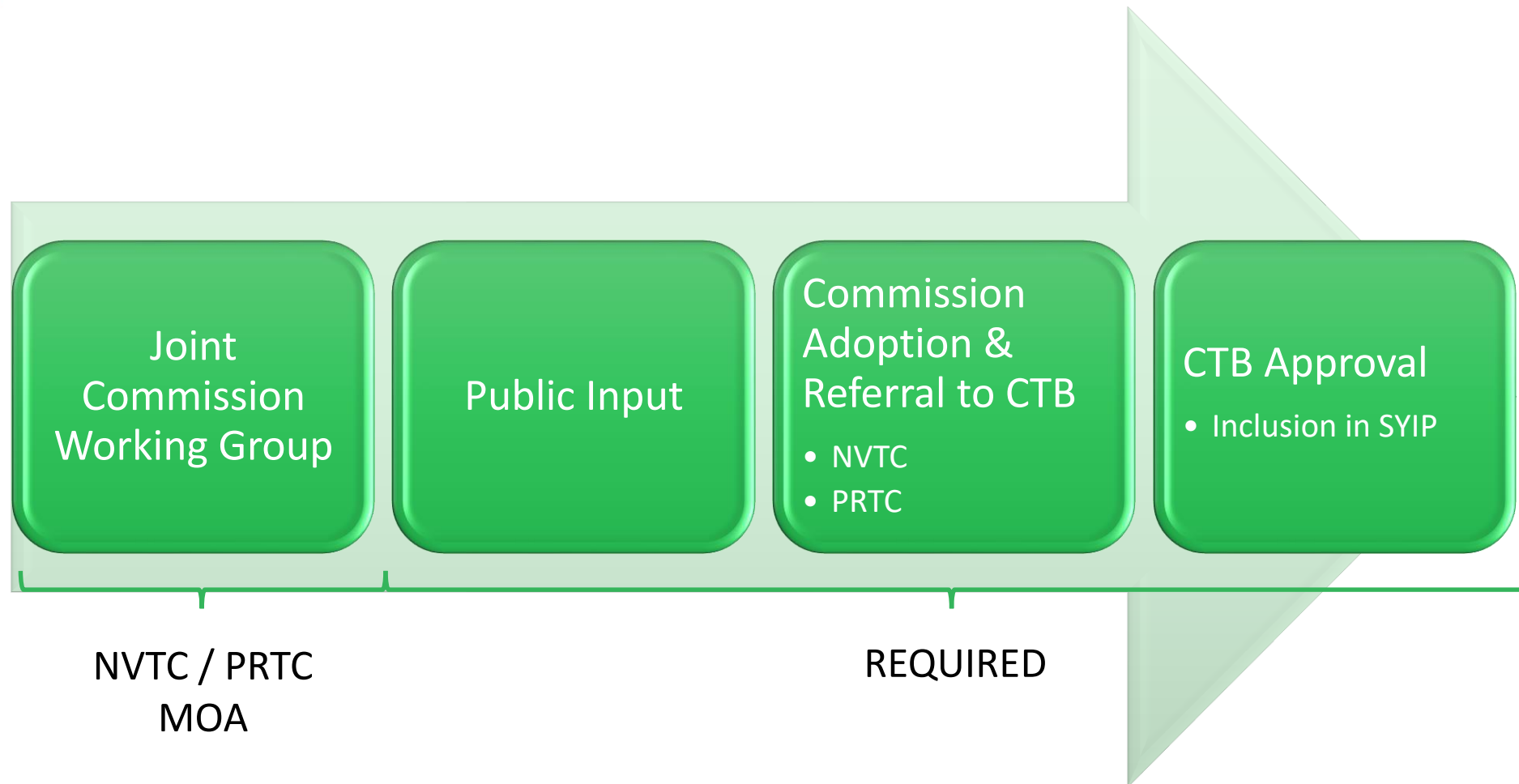

- 17 applications for \$31.3M in funding
- Variety of Projects:
 - New bus service
 - Enhanced bus service
 - Access to Transit
 - Intersection / roadway improvements
 - TDM

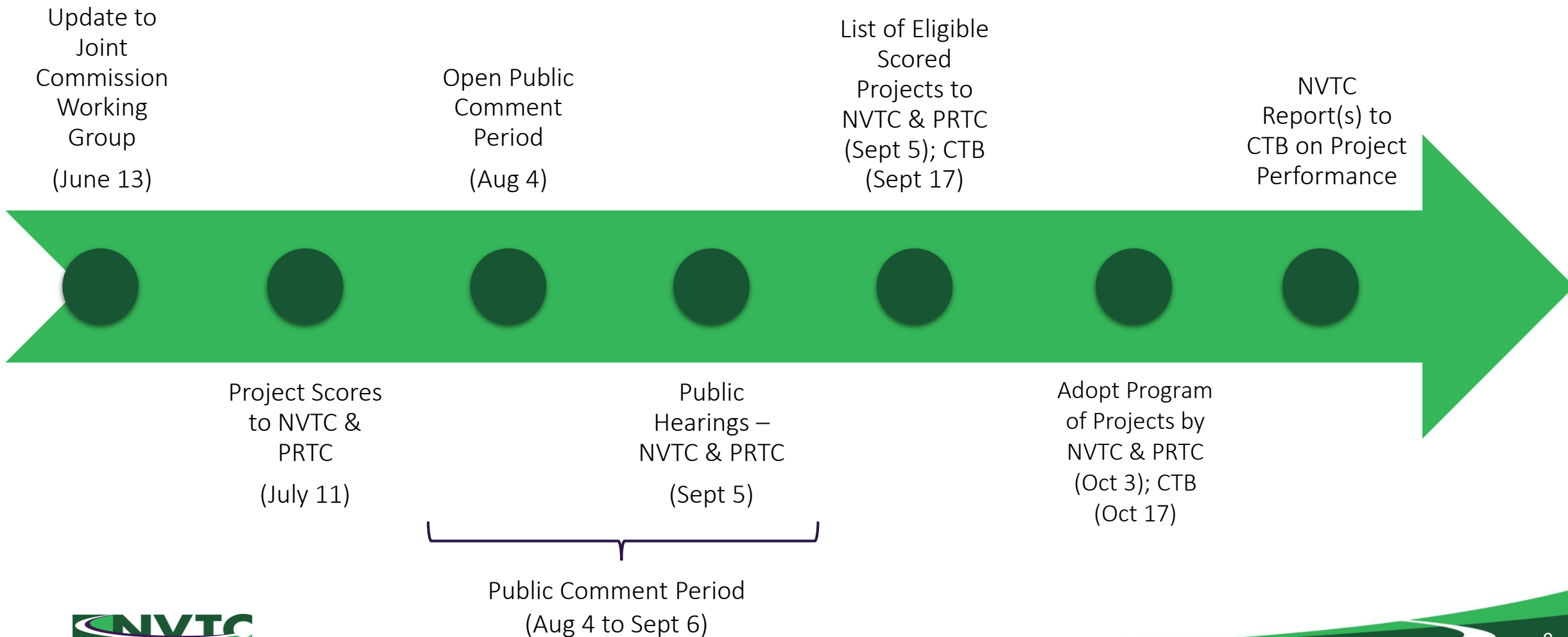
Program Development Approach



- Protects the integrity of the program
- Quantitative approach supported by data
- Projects scored by technical team in coordination with jurisdiction/transit agency staff
- Similar to other competitive programs – i.e. SMART SCALE, MERIT (DRPT)
