



RESOLUTION #2567

SUBJECT: Authorize the VRE CEO to Execute a Third Amendment to the Agreement with Amtrak for Access and Storage at Washington Union Terminal

WHEREAS: VRE's current access and storage agreement with Amtrak expires June 30, 2025, and includes a provision to amend the current agreement, extending the term for an additional five years starting July 1, 2025, ending on June 30, 2030;

WHEREAS: The current agreement includes access and mid-day storage at Washington Union Terminal (WUT);

WHEREAS: VRE and Amtrak staff have updated various sections of the current agreement to reflect the current state of VRE operations;

WHEREAS: The new agreement will provide VRE with continued access and mid-day storage and other services at Washington Union Terminal (WUT); and

WHEREAS: The VRE Operations Board recommends the following action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission does hereby authorize the VRE Chief Executive Officer to execute a Third Amendment to the Agreement for Commuter Rail Passenger Service Access to Washington Union Terminal and Station and Storage of Commuter Rail Passenger Equipment to exercise the option to extend the term of the Agreement by five years through June 30, 2030.
